Introduced as an output device for the ZX81, the ZX Printer is also directly compatible with the Spectrum. It offers an inexpensive method by which home computer users can obtain printed results and lists of programs. Though its ow initial cost is attractive, its reliance on electrostatic paper leaves it at a distinct disadvahtage

Aquarius Printer

Aquarius chose the other low cost operating method for its home microcomputer — thermal printing, though an nexpensive four-colour printer, which uses ball-point pens, is also available. Like the ZX Printer, it suffers through having to rely on special paper
