

If you know the answers to these questions, chances are you're a *Trivial Pursuit* champion. Finally it's here. The worldwide smash hit board game has at last made the transition to computer. And what a fun-packed conversion it has turned out to be.

If you've played the board game you'll already be familiar with the scenario of answering questions from several categories to beat your opponents to the centre hub of the board.

But check out the additional features of the electronic version: automatic dice rolling, automatic indication of possible moves, fabulous sound and music effects, a gigantic repertoire of more than 3,000 questions (many utilising sound and graphics), a unique optional fail safe control that ensures you do not get asked the same question twice, and the ability to at last play *Trivial Pursuit* on your own!

Authentic and officially approved

No effort has been spared to make the computerised release of *Trivial Pursuit* as sophisticated and enjoyable as the board game. The same team of Oxford academics who produced the acclaimed computer version of Shakespeare's "Macbeth" has ensured the authenticity of the new game which has had the approval and blessing of the originators of *Trivial Pursuit*.


Not only do they have skills in maths, computing, art, design, physics, and English, but all the game's designers and programmers are avid *Trivial Pursuit* players.

They realised that part of the fun of the game is to let the players call out the answers to the questions. And so it remains with the computer game. The key to the new version is "TP", the computerised master of ceremonies who directs game play. And if the little fellow gets too tiresome, just turn him off and carry on without him.

Two-part program

When you open your *Trivial Pursuit* pack you'll find the program is in two parts. The first section




ever comes to life with sound and well as text!

is the main structure containing the board and logic control that will set the rules, spin the dice, set the time limit for answers, move players and act as umpire.

Once this is up and running you can insert the question pack programs. These are the databases full of hundreds of questions covering all the familiar *Trivial Pursuit* categories: history, entertainment, science, sport, and geography.

This is where the computer *Trivial Pursuit* leaves the board game far behind, as shown in these representative screen shots. For, questions can be based not only on simple text, but also on graphics and sound (or any combination of the three).




Keyboard or joystick controlled

Once the game has started, you'll be asked to set the names of the players, time limits for answers, and change subject categories. Ready? Just press your joystick button or hit the pre-selected key and watch the dice roll, see the possible squares on the board flash, as the first question pops up onto the screen. If you can't respond within the pre-set time limit, the answer will appear on the screen. Or you can summon up the correct answer at any time by hitting the appropriate key or joystick button.

Just as in the board game, each player has a segmented counter into which the coloured wedges symbolising success at answering a key category are inserted. Only this time the counters appear as screen icons and the wedges are automatically "inserted" by the computer.

If "TP" is being utilised, you'll see the little fellow push your counter to the appropriate

square, run off with the board, and re-enter to ask the next question.

As soon as the question has been processed and answered it can be deleted from the computer's memory. So you can be sure it will not be asked again in that game.

Not only does *Trivial Pursuit* make a fabulous Christmas present. Its all-round appeal is bound to give hours of fun to the whole family. Who cares about long autumn nights when there is *Trivial Pursuit* to enjoy?

Icon selection does away with tedious typing of commands.

You interact with the characters in *Movie* through a comprehensive menu of icons controlled by keyboard or joystick. To move around, activate the “footprint” symbol. Firing the gun is as easy as selecting the

“gun” symbol while other icons let you punch out during combat, throw objects at the heavies, pick up essential objects and halt the action at any time.

You can even talk to the characters by selecting the speech bubble. They will react according to what you say.

The action starts in your office on the shadier side of town but soon you’re out in the alleys and other buildings in the neighbourhood checking out leads and clues. All around shady characters move in and out of the scene. Some are friendly. Others indicate danger. There’s so much detail packed into each location that you’ll want to spend time examining the dozens of objects. But first you have to find a gun.
