## SUNDAY 8th




The cow is of the bovine ilk. One end is moo, the other, milk.

## MONDAY 16th





One of the strangest diseases ever is green monkey disease. Your arms get really long and your whole body turns the colour of the water that brussel sprouts have been cooked in.







## MONDAY 30th





Turtles can live up to 200 years in the wild, so Leonardo, Michaelangelo and Robert will be around for some time to come. Worse luck.

## SUNDAY 5th




The oldest man in the world is Japanese. He's 121 years old (unless he's died before you read this).
