



Dear Gert

I think the saying goes "Give and you shall receive". As the magazine will be given then I feel something can be given in return and you will hear from me from time to time.

## TAPE PROBLEMS

I had a lot of problems at one stage and finally found two possible causes (aside from lousy tape recorders or tapes), which can be sorted out.

### 1. Tape head saturation.

Basically what happens is that after continuous use at the same frequency (which is what happens on the computer), the read/write heads become magnetically saturated and the you could be able to load tapes but not save them. In fact the tape recorder behaves as if it is broken. Myself and two others at work experienced the same problem. One chap had the Sanyo Data Recorder.

The answer to this is a Head Demagnetizer. These can be bought (between R35 & R50). It takes one record and the tape recorders work like new again. One of my recorders actually stayed on the shelf for a year as I had given it up and had already bought a new one. Now its working fine.

### 2. Tape Drive Wheel.

This is the rubber wheel which moves forward onto the motor drive spindle. The tape runs between these two components and this is what gives the tape its motion. For those who are finding that their tape recorders seem to work fine the one moment and then not the next possibly have a problem here. What happens is that the rubber wheel picks up dirt from the tapes or perhaps dust from the room. Clean the

rubber wheel with IOPROPYL Alcohol using one of those cotton buds. Again a miracle occurs on the recorder. With the dirt on these heads it does not grip the tape and so sometimes it the tape slips. The result is that the recording/playback speeds are not constant. When this happens, nothing seems to want to save or load.



# SUPERQBOARD

MANUAL

The QL has two serial ports which can be used for devices, mostly printers and plotters. Also included in the low price of R699 (or less), are two microdrives. The QLs standard memory is a full 128K (RAM).


QL users normally upgrade on these three fields as the need arises. The SUPER-Q-BOARD from SANDY is a three-in-one upgrade for the QL user who'd like to do it in one go. The Super-Q-Board incorporates a parallel printer interface, a disc drive interface and a 512K RAM upgrade. Also included is a ROM based copy of Tony Tebby's Super Toolkit.

In this review I will not attempt to say anything about the latter. This will have to be reviewed as a separate unit.

The price of the interface is approximately R1075. Yup, one thousand and seventy five of the small ones. If you think this is not a steal at the price you will most probably be right. If you buy a printer interface, a disc interface, 512K RAM and Toolkit (software) separately you will pay more or less R1100. Why should one then make such a huge capital outlay if you could gradually buy the separate units? There are two reasons. Firstly, a single interface looks neater than three interfaces piled on top of each other or behind each other. The second reason is that the four components of this interface, (disc/printer/RAM/Toolkit) have been designed to be interactive, which you are not likely to get if you buy them all separately.

Looks. If your appreciation for good looks also include computers, the Super-Q-Board will rate very high in your book. The interface is 15cm long, and if it is stuck into position on the right of the computer, only 6cm sticks out. This part is made of the same material as the QL, and is black (and beautiful). The cables for the printer and disc drive plugs into the left of the interface.

SUPERBOARD INTERFACE



The manual consists of 60 pages, divided into 6 sections - one section on each of the interfaces, one on the Toolkit and two on installation and introduction. It has a ring binder, its size is A5, and has a semi-hard cover as well as semi-hard divided between the different sections. It is very explanatory. However, the Toolkit section looked as if it would need some struggling to understand, but then as I said before I did not attempt to have a real go at it.

## FLOPPY DISC DRIVER

The QLs disc operating system (QDOS) allows for other storage devices which behave similar to the QLs microdrives to be added transparently. This means that having added the Super-Q-Board, you do not need a new set of commands. All microdrive (mdv\_) commands apply and the prefix 'flp' is used when the floppy should be used. The filing commands are used as before :

- FORMAT flp1\_name : will format a new disc in drive one,
- DIR flp1\_ : makes a directory of the floppy in disc one,
- SAVE flp1\_name : saves the current SUPERBASIC program to floppy one,
- OPEN\_NEW #3, flp2\_data : creates and opens a new file 'data' on floppy disk 2,
- COPY mdv1\_x TO flp1\_x : copies the program 'x' from microdrive one to floppy drive one.

You might think that it is going to be a big task to transfer the 4 Psion programs to floppy. This is made easy by microdrive emulation using the command FLP\_USE MDV. This command tells QDOS to transfer all mdv\_ commands to flp\_ i.e. if you enter FLP\_USE MDV and thereafter you enter DIR mdv1\_ a directory of flp1\_ will be made. To use the 4 Psion programs is very easy - all it needs is a slight alteration of the 4 'boot' programs.

The SUPER-Q-BOARDS disc interface not only supports all the build-in Microdrive filing system operations, but includes all the extended filing system operations provided in the Toolkit for Microdrives. Examples are:

OPEN OVERWRITE - this variant of the OPEN call opens a file for write/read whether it exists or not,

RENAME - this call renames a file,

TRUNCATE - this truncates a file to the current byte position.

In addition the FS.FLUSH call for a file not only flushes all the file buffers, but also enables one to read all of a file (up to the point where it was last flushed) if the power was turned off before a file was CLOSED.

When one switches the QL on, normally the pressing F1 or F2 results in a spinning microdrive, looking for a file called 'boot' to load and run. With the Super-Q-Board attached, a test is carried out before the F1 and F2 options appear to see whether a disc is in floppy drive one. If not, pressing F1 or F2 will boot from microdrive one. If a disc is in drive one, it will boot drive one when you press F1.

#### 512K RAM

The first thing a QL user will do when he buys (any) RAM upgrade, is to load Abacus to see whether the miserable 17K for use is upped by 512. This is not the case. Only (1) 475K is available after 512K RAM because the QL uses some of the additional memory for 'administration' of the additional memory.

However, although one will use the Super-Q-Board's additional memory without thinking twice about it, it only comes into its right when the Toolkit's RAM DISC DRIVER is used (which is built in!). The term 'RAM disc' is a misnomer. It is used to denote a 'virtual' device (one that only exists in the fertile imagination of the QL) that looks and behaves like a very fast disc device. It is so fast because being virtual, there is virtually nothing to move to get information in and out. It is, in fact, no more than a reserved area of the QL's main memory (RAM - random access memory). This means of course, that any space taken up by a RAM disc is not available to programs executing in the QL. Furthermore, any data stored in a RAM disc will be lost when the QL is turned off or reset.

The normal use of a RAM disc would be to copy all working files from Microdrive (or floppy) into a RAM disc; rename the RAM device to be mdv\_, execute the program, and when finished rename the RAM device to be RAM before copying the data files back to Microdrive.

The RAM device can just as easily be used as a RAM device without being renamed, using the following commands:

FORMAT ram2\_name : creates a new RAM disc 2

DIR rami\_ : directory of RAM disc 1

SAVE rami\_prog : save the current  
SUPERBASIC pro-gram as 'prog' in  
RAM disc 1.

(All other microdrive commands are supported)

#### PRINTER PORT

There are two serial ports at the back of the QL, and these are identified by the name SER. Likewise the Super-Q-Board's parallel printer port is identified by the name PAR.

Most programs, including the 4 Psion programs are written to use the serial port SER1. The Super-Q-Board's command PAR\_USE SER makes it possible to use these programs without any changes. The data will then be sent to the PARallel port instead of the SERIAL port. As with the command FLP\_USE MDV, the easiest is to edit the 'boot' programs of the Psion package.

One of my reasons for saying that the Super-Q-Board, although not a lot cheaper than the separate interfaces, is a good buy was that the separate interfaces will not be as interactive as the Super-Q-Board. This 'interactiveness' of the Super-Q-Board comes to its full potential when the extra RAM is used in conjunction with the PARallel port - as a printer buffer. A printer buffer, bought for a printer, will cost you a few hundred rand. And everyone who has a permanent printer buffer fixed into his/her printer, know how frustrating it could be if you press ESC, but because of the buffer the printer will happily print along until the 4K (or more) buffer has been emptied. Thus, you could have a printer buffer using PAR and RAM, but you are not stuck with it.

The command for setting up a buffer is as easy as all the other Super-Q-Board commands: PAR\_3K will set up 3K buffer and PARC\_400 will set up a 400 buffer with the PARallel interface set with <CR> in place of <LF> as newline.

#### CONCLUSION

R1075 is a lot of money, but if you are using your QL a lot, it could be worth it. I hope to become more familiar with the Super Toolkit, which, as I said above is included on ROM in this interface, is also available as separate software. A review on this will hopefully appear in a future newsletter.


